MEMORANDUM ORDER

SUBJECT: TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC AND WILD BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY OLD CHICKS, EGGS AND SEMEN ORIGINATING FROM CHINESE TAIPEI.

WHEREAS, based on the official reports submitted by Dr Ping-Cheng Yang, Vice President, Agriculture Technology Research Institute, Council of Agriculture, Hsinchu City, Chinese Taipei to the Office Internationale Des Epizooties (OIE), that there was a series of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) outbreaks in the following Chinese Taipei counties: Yunlin, Chiayi, and Pingtung and Kaohsiung City from the period of January 11 to 16, 2015;

WHEREAS, the outbreaks were caused by H5N2, H5N3 and H5N8 HPAI virus affecting geese and duck farms as confirmed by the Animal Health Research Institute (National laboratory) thru real-time polymerase chain reaction (PCR);


WHEREAS, the OIE Animal Health Information Department: H5 and H7 High Pathogenicity Avian Influenza viruses are among the notifiable OIE Listed terrestrial animal diseases, infections and infestations in force in 2015;


WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the entry of HPAI virus to protect the health of the public and the local poultry population;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PROCESO J. ALCALA, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergency measures:

1. Banning the importation of domestic and wild birds, including poultry meat, day old chicks, eggs, and semen from *CHINESE TAIPEI*;¹
2. Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation of the application and issuance of Sanitary and Phytosanitary (SPS) import clearance to the above-stated commodities from *CHINESE TAIPEI*;
3. Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of the above stated commodities (with the exception on heat treated products and poultry meat with slaughter/production date before October 31, 2014) into the country originating from *CHINESE TAIPEI* by all DA Veterinary Quarantine Officers/Inspectors at all major ports.
4. Importation of meat products of poultry is subject to the conditions provided in article 10.4.19, 10.4.20 and 10.4.26 of the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code, 2014.²

This ORDER shall take effect immediately.

¹ Heat treated products are acceptable following chapter 10.4 of the OIE Terrestrial Animal Health Code (2014) recommending, provided that in addition to the Veterinary Health Certificate, the Competent Authority will include in the certification the following:

1. Temperature and the duration of heating or pasteurization of products; and
2. There is no commingling of raw materials with any other materials of animal origin.
