BPI SPECIAL QUARAN INE ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. $\frac{20}{1980}$

SUBJECT:

Palawan Island Group Under Quar ntine
to Prevent the Spread of Said Pest.

WHEREAL, it has been determined by the Director of Plant Industry that the mango pulp weevil <u>Sternochetus</u> <u>frigidus</u> is injurious to mango fruits;

#EREAS, mango is now one of our non-traditional
export nonmodity;

WEAS, our infant mange growing industry requires appropr ate protection from injurious plant pasts and disease ;

whereas, after extensive survey it was found that mange pulp weevil Sternochetus frigidus exists in sove. al areas of the Palawan Island group only;

Sternochetus frigidus should be prevented and its existeradicated.

NUW, THIREFURE, pursuant to the authority vested in the Director of Plant Industry by P.D. 1433, otherwise known as the Plant Quarantine Decree of 1978, this Special arder is hereby promulgated, as follows:

frigidus is nereby declared as an injurious and dangerous pest of mangoes:

SECTION 2. The Palawan Island group is hereby declared and placed under quarantine in accordance with Section 8, P.D. 1433 as implemented by Section 1, Rule JI of 3PI quarantine Administrative Order No. 1, Series of 1981;

SECTION 3. The movement, transfer or carrying of mango trees, fruits or parts thereof capable of harboring mango pulp weevil from Palawan Island group is hereby prohibited. Provided, however, that the movement and transfer or carrying of said mango trees, fruits or parts thereof may be allowed in limited quantity and for experimental purposes only, subject to the conditions that a permit for such purpose is first secured from the Director ant stry or his duly authorized representative and like subject to the provisions of Section 4, Rule VI of the LFI Quarantine Administrative Order No. 1, peries of 1981;

SECTION 4. In order to carry out effective quarantine and control measures against the spread of mango pulp weevil, the Director of Plant Industry, in accordance with Section 16 of P.D. 1433, may request national, provincial, municipal and barangay officials and members of the Armed Forces in Palawan Island group to assist in the implementation/enforcement of such instituted plant quarantine measures in order to contain, prevent the spread and ultimately eradicate the said pest;

SECTION 5. All companies engaged in land, water or air transportation shall not ship or convey mange trees, fruits or parts thereof from any of the Palawan Island group to any part of the country except for those covered by Section 3 hereof;

SECTION 6. Any person who violates the provisions of this Order or forges, counterfeits, alters, defaces and destroys any document issued by virtue hereof shall suffer the penalties provided for under Section 23 of P.O. 1433 of which is a fine in an amount of not more than P20,000.00 or imprisonment from prision correctional to prision mayor, or both, at the discretion of the Court;

SECTION 7. This Order supersedes and revokes orders inconsistent herewith and shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication as required by law.
