Subject: EXPORT OF PET ANIMALS TO INDONESIA

Date: 18 January 2005

In view of the declaration of all the island of Java areas, including the Province of Jakarta, Banten and West Java as Rabies-free zones areas and as per Indonesia's Directorate General of Livestock Services, Department of Agriculture's Note No. 115/PD.660/F/12.04 dated 6 December 2004, please be informed that the export of pet animals (dog, cat, monkey, raccoon, skunks, fox) to Indonesia shall be allowed until 5 March 2005 subject to the following conditions:

- a. The animal must be examined by a duly-licensed veterinarian.
- b. The animal must be vaccinated against rabies at least one (1) month prior to departure.
- c. The exporter must request for a certification/recommendation letter from the Director of Animal Health, Directorate General of Livestock Services, Department of Agriculture of the Republic of Indonesia.
- d. The exporter must secure an approval letter from the Department of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia (Directorate for Diplomatic Facilities).
