Supplement for Memorandum Order No. 103 "Revised Protocol for the Export of Fresh Okra to Japan."

This Memorandum is issued as supplement for Memorandum Order No. 103 Series of 2008 "Revised Protocol for the Export of Fresh Okra to Japan."

SUPPLEMENTARY GUIDELINES FOR THE ACCREDITATION OF OKRA EXPORTERS AND FARMER/GROWERS TO JAPAN

I. Exporters

Requirements

In addition to Items 1 to 6 which are already in effect, the following requirements will be added:

- Item # 7. After accreditation of the BPI as endorsed by the ASC, New Exporter shall be subjected to 20 shipment mandatory residue analysis both by NPAL and Japan MHLW.
 - 7.1 Samples will be randomly collected by the Plant Quarantine Inspector from the packing facility from each shipment until 20 shipment mandatory residue analysis is completed.
- Item #8. The new exporter will be endorsed by BPI to the MHLW for inclusion in the list of exporters exempted in the 100% inspection order only if the result of the analysis is satisfactory.
 - 8.1 Monitoring of Pesticide residue shall be done every other week for each exporter to be collected alternately by BPI-NPAL for field sampling and BPI-PQS for packing facility sampling.

This Memorandum shall take effect immediately.
