SUBJECT: Rules and Regulation for the Accreditation of New Asparagus and Mango Exporters


This Memorandum is issued for the guidance of all concerned and to maintain the random inspection status of Philippine asparagus and mango export to Japan.

GUIDELINES FOR THE ACCREDITATION OF MANGO AND ASPARAGUS EXPORTERS TO JAPAN

- I. Exporters Requirements
 - 1.1 Submit Application for Accreditation together with all documentary Requirements
 - 1.2 Exporter orientation
 - 1.3 Facility Inspection
 - 1.4 Equipment Testing if necessary
 - 1.5 Accreditation
 - 1.6 After accreditation of the BPI. The New Exporter shall be subjected to 20 shipment mandatory residue analysis by NPAL.
 - 1.6.1 Samples will be randomly collected by the Plant Quarantine Inspector from the packing facility from each shipment until 20 shipment mandatory residue analysis is completed.
 - 1.7 The new exporter will be endorsed by BPI to the MHLW to be included in the list of exporters exempted from the 100% inspection order only if the result of the analysis of the first 20 shipments are satisfactory.
 - 1.7.1 Monitoring of Pesticide residue every quarter from each farm manager of each exporter to be collected by BPI-NPAL and FPA through field sampling shall be conducted.

This Memorandum shall take effect immediately.
