(REPUBLIC ACT NO. 925)

AN ACT AMENDING ACT NUMBERED THIRTY-TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE EXPORTATION TO FOREIGN COUNTRIES OF SEEDS OF ABACA AND ITS DERIVATIVES"

it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The title and sections one and two of Act Numbered hirty-two hundred fifty-one, are amended, to read as follows:

"AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE EXPORTATION OF SEEDS, SEEDLINGS, SUCKERS, OR ROOTSTOCKS OF ABACA"

"SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, corporation, or ssociation to export seeds, seedlings, suckers or rootstocks of the lant commonly known as "abaca".

SEC. 2. Violations of this Act shall be punished by imprisonment or not less than two months nor more than two years, or a fine of not ess than one hundred pesos nor more than twenty thousand, or both, in the discretion of the count, and the seeds, seedlings, suckers, or root-tocks which it is attempted to export shall be forfeited to the Government: Provided, That if the offenders are foreigners, they shall be ined twenty thousand pesos and deported immediately".

This Act, which originated in the House of Representatives was inally passed by the same on May 18, 1950.
