## Administrative Order No. 29 Series of 2002

## Subject : ACCREDITATION OF CHAISHAN MEATS AND FOOD COMPANYU TO EXPORT COOKED PORK SKIN TO THE PHILIPPINES FROM TAIWAN

- Whereas, the Philippine Department of Agriculture Mission to Taiwan, after through investigation and evaluation of the disease situation, quarantine procedures, meat inspection system, meat plant found favorable conditions that merit allowing the importation of cooked pork skin from Taiwan;
- Whereas, the meat establishment, CHAISHAN MEATS AND FOOD COMPANY, was visited and found to have complied with Philippine requirements for the accreditation of meat establishment:

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS P. LORENZO, JR.,** Secretary of Agriculture, by the virtue of power vested in me by law, do hereby issue this order granting accreditation of above stated meat plant to export cooked pork skin.

All import transactions of the above products shall be in accordance with the existing rules and regulations of the Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Animal Industry and National Meat Inspection Commission (DA-BAI-NMIC).

All importations from this plant must be covered by a pre-inspection certificate issued by a third party stating that the pork skin is cooked and was processed and packed under strict sanitary condition.

All orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this order, are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

This ORDER shall take effect immediately.
