MEMORANDUM ORDER

No.: 13 Series 2004

SUBJECT: TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC AND WILD BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY-OLD CHICKS, EGGS AND SEMEN ORIGINATING FROM COLUMBIA, CANADA

WHEREAS, the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) has confirmed the occurrence of avian influenza on a farm in British Columbia;

WHEREAS, about 16,000 birds in the farm were destroyed because they were susceptible;

WHEREAS, the Philippines Imports birds from Canada;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the entry of avian influenza to prevent the health of the local poultry population;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LUIS P. LORENZO, JR., Secretary of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergency measures:

> 1. Banning the importation of domestic and wild birds and their products, including day-old chicks, eggs and semen from British Columbia, Canada,

> 2. Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation and issuance of veterinary quarantine clearance/ International veterinary certificate/ import permit for applications relevant to the importation of the abovestated commodities from British Columbia, Canada by the Bureau of Animal Industry.

> 3. Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of poultry and poultry products into the country originating from British Columbia, Canada by all

DA Quarantine Officers/ Inspectors at all major sea/airports.

This ORDER shall take effect immediately.
