MEMORANDUM ORDER

SUBJECT: TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC

AND WILD BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY-OLD CHICKS, EGGS AND SEMEN ORIGINATING FROM THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN,

WHEREAS, based on the report submitted to the Office International des Epizooties (OIE) last September 28, 2007, a Highly Pathogenic

Avian Influenza (HPAI) virus serotype H7N3 has been detected;

WHEREAS, the outbreak was on a poultry farm in Regina District, Saskatchewan Province, Canada;

WHEREAS, the Philippines imports poultry and other birds from Canada;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the entry of HPAI virus to protect the health of the local poultry population, as well as human health;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JESUS EMMANUEL M. PARAS**, Officer-In-Charge of the Department of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergencies:

- Banning the importation of domestic and wild birds and their products, including day-old chicks, eggs and semen from the Province of Saskatchewan, Canada.
- Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation of the application and issuance of Veterinary Quarantine Clearance to import the above-stated commodities from the Province of Saskatchewan, Canada by the Bureau of Animal Industry.
- Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of poultry and poultry products into the country originating from the Province of Saskatchewan, Canada by all DA Veterinary Quarantine Officers/ Inspectors at all major ports.

This ORDER shall take effect immediately.
