MEMORANDUM ORDER

SUBJECT:

TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF FMD-SUSCEPTIBLE

ANIMALS, THEIR PRODUCTS AND BY-PRODUCTS ORIGINATING FROM

BULGARIA

WHEREAS, based on the official report submitted to the Office International des Epizooties last 7 January 2011, by Dr. Tsviatko Alexandrov, Chief Expert and OIE contact point for Bulgaria, there was a confirmed case of Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) in Bulgaria;

WHEREAS, the FMD was confirmed last 4 January 2011 in three wild boars that were shot during the normal season hunting in an area located at around 2km from the Bulgarian border with the Republic of Turkey;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the entry of FMD-susceptible animals, their products and by-products originating from Bulgaria to protect the health of the local livestock population;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PROCESO J. ALCALA, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergency measures:

- 1. Banning the importation of FMD-susceptible animals, their products and by-products originating from Bulgaria;
- 2. Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation of the application and issuance of Veterinary Quarantine Clearance (VQC) to Import of the above-stated commodities from Bulgaria by the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI);
- 3. Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of FMD-susceptible animals, their products and by-products into the country originating from Bulgaria by all DA Veterinary Quarantine Officers/Inspectors at all major ports.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
