SUBJECT: **TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC AND WILD BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY OLD CHICKS, EGGS AND SEMEN ORIGINATING FROM UKRAINE**

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Petr I. Verbytskiy, Head, State Department for Veterinary Medicine, Ministry of Agricultural Policy, Kiev submitted a report to the Office International des Epizooties (OIE) last December 5, 2005 regarding outbreaks of avian influenza virus serotype H5 in Ukraine;

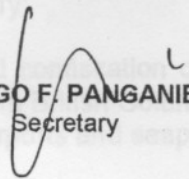
**WHEREAS**, the outbreaks were reported in the villages of Pushkino and Zavet-Leninskoe, Dzhankovskiy District, Izobilnoe and Yemelyanovka, Nizhnegorskiy District, and Nekrasovka, Sovetskiy district, Autonomous Republic of Crimea;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to prevent the entry of Avian Influenza virus to protect the health of the local poultry population;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, DOMINGO F. PANGANIBAN**, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergency measures:

1. Banning the importation of domestic and wild birds and their products, including day-old chicks, eggs and semen from Ukraine;
2. Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation and issuance of Veterinary Quarantine Clearance/International Veterinary Certificate/Import Permit for applications relevant to the importation of the above-stated commodities from Ukraine by the Bureau of Animal Industry;
3. Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of poultry and poultry products into the country originating from Ukraine by all DA Veterinary Quarantine Officers/Inspectors at all major airports and seaports.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
