MEMORANDUM ORDER No. 27 Series 2005

SUBJECT:

TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC AND WILD BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY OLD CHICKS, EGGS AND

SEMEN ORIGINATING FROM UKRAINE

WHEREAS, Dr. Petr I. Verbytskiy, Head, State Department for Veterinary Medicine, Ministry of Agricultural Policy, Kiev submitted a report to the Office International des Epizooties (OIE) last December 5, 2005 regarding outbreaks of avian influenza virus serotype H5 in Ukraine;

WHEREAS, the outbreaks were reported in the villages of Pushkino and Zavet-Leninskoe, Dzhankoyskiy District, Izobilnoe and Yemelyanovka, Nizhnegorskiy District, and Nekrasovka, Sovetskiy district, Autonomous Republic of Crimea;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the entry of Avian Influenza virus to protect the health of the local poultry population;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DOMINGO F. PANGANIBAN, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergency measures:

- 1. Banning the importation of domestic and wild birds and their products, including day-old chicks, eggs and semen from Ukraine;
- Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation and issuance of Veterinary Quarantine Clearance/International Veterinary Certificate/Import Permit for applications relevant to the importation of the above-stated commodities from Ukraine by the Bureau of Animal Industry;
- Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of poultry and poultry products into the country originating from Ukraine by all DA Veterinary Quarantine Officers/Inspectors at all major airports and seaports.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
