MEMORANDUM ORDER

GUIDELINES IN THE REGISTRATION AND IMPORTATION OF MEAT AND BONE MEAL FROM NEW ZEALAND

In view of the approval of DA-Memorandum Order No. 07, series of 2007, dated 22 May 2007, which provides for the lifting of the temporary ban on the importation of **Meat and Bone Meal** from **New Zealand**, the following guidelines are hereby adopted for the information and guidance of all concerned:

BAI registration of the **Meat and Bone Meal** shall be required prior to the importation of the said product. The following documents shall be submitted as requirements for registration:

 Official Establishment (Risk Management Programme)
 Number issued by the New Zealand Food Safety Authority (NZFSA), and full address of the establishment;

Copy of Risk Management Programme Registration Certificate issued by NZFSA;

Processing Method of the product including time, temperature and other parameters;

4. A NZFSA Veterinary Health Certificate;

5. Certificate of Analysis showing the following:

5.1 Complete proximate analysis; and

5.2 Salmonella test; and

6. Facsimile or draft or photograph of the proposed label or tag.

A NZFSA Veterinary Health Certificate shall accompany every consignment and shall include the following:

 A statement that the product is freely available for sale in New Zealand;

- A statement that the product is of New Zealand origin;

 A statement that the meal will be used only for poultry/swine/aquaculture feeds and pet food purposes in the Philippines; and

- A list of diseases relevant to the product that do not occur in

New Zealand.

Likewise, **Import Permits** shall be required for every shipment of meat and bone meal to be imported from the said country. The following documents shall accompany the application form for Import Permits:

1. Product registration;

2. Proforma Invoice;

3. List of clients to be supplied with the meat and bone meal; and

4. Inventory of the meat and bone meal (for those who have already made previous importations).

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain enforced until revoked.
