**MEMORANDUM ORDER** 

No. 05 Series 2007

SUBJECT:

TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC AND WILD BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY OLD CHICKS, EGGS AND SEMEN ORIGINATING FROM BANGLADESH

WHEREAS, based on the report submitted to the Office International des Epizooties (OIE) last 30 March 2007, a Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) virus serotype H5N1 has been detected;

WHEREAS, the outbreak was on a poultry farm in Jamalpur, Dhaka Div, Bangladesh;

WHEREAS, there is a possibility that travelers may bring in pet birds, poultry and poultry products from Bangladesh;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the entry of HPAI virus to protect the health of the local poultry population, as well as human health;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ARTHUR C. YAP, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergency measures:

- 1. Banning the importation of domestic and wild birds and their products, including dayold chicks, eggs and semen from Bangladesh;
- 2. Immediate suspension of the issuance of Veterinary Quarantine Clearance (VQC) to import the above stated commodities from Bangladesh;
- Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of poultry and poultry products into the country originating from Bangladesh by all DA Quarantine Officers/Inspectors at all major airports and seaports.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
