**Subject: ACCREDITATION OF K & K2 FOODS LTD. OF
CHANG-HWA PREFECTURE IN TAIWAN AS AN
EXPORTER OF BEEF PATTIES**

WHEREAS, the Philippine Department of Agriculture Mission in Taiwan after a thorough investigation and evaluation of the disease situation in the country, meat inspection system and manufacturing practices and procedures found favorable conditions that merit allowing the importation of beef patties from Taiwan.

NOW THEREFORE, I, **EDGARDO J. ANGARA**, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, do hereby issue this guidelines governing the importation of beef patties from Taiwan.


That, the raw meat materials used for processing of beef patties must come from countries / establishments that are also accredited in the Philippines.

That, only beef patties processed at the **K & K2 Foods Ltd., Chang-Hwa Prefecture in Taiwan** are allowed for importation.


That, all import transactions of such beef patties shall be in accordance with the existing rules and regulations of the National Meat Inspection Commission and Bureau of Animal Industry.


All orders, rules and regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.
