SUBJECT

: TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF LIVE CATTLE, SHEEP AND GOATS, THEIR MEAT AND MEAT PRODUCTS; BOVINE SEMEN AND EMBRYO; MEAT AND BONE-MEAL AND OTHER FEED INGREDIENTS DERIVED FROM THE SAID ANIMALS FROM SWITZERLAND, UNITED KINGDOM, IRELAND, PORTUGAL, FRANCE, GERMANY, ITALY AND THE

NETHERLANDS.

Per recommendation of DR. DALMACIO S. SALTING, Agricultural Attache to Brussels, you are hereby directed to implement a temporary ban on the importation of live cattle, sheep and goats, their meat and meat products; bovine semen and embryo; meat and bone-meal and other feed ingredients derived from the said animals originating from SWITZERLAND, UNITED KINGDOM, IRELAND, PORTUGAL, FRANCE, GERMANY, ITALY AND THE NETHERLANDS as a precautionary measure against the increasing incidence of Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) or "Mad Cow Disease" in the aforementioned areas.


