## Amendatory Notice to Section 1 of Administrative Order No. 1. Series of 1965

For the purpose of complying fully with the very intents and purposes of Adm. Order No. 1, Series of 1965 which declares the Coffee Berry Borer (Stephanoderes hampei Ferrari) a dangerous pest, providing for its control and placing under quarantine all provinces where the pest exists, NOTICE is hereby given and posted that in view of the rapid widespread of the pest from one province to another within the Island of Mindanao and of the various islands and islets within the periphery of said Mindanao Island, and of the Island City of Basilan together with the various Islands comprising the Sulu Archipelago, it is expedient that strict quarantine measures and field control be instituted to check any further spread of the pest to any of the provinces and islands of the Visayas and Luzon and as such, Section 1 of Adm. Order No. 1, Series of 1965 shall henceforth stands and read as follows:

Section 1.

For the purposes of this Adm. Order, all municipalities in ALL THE PROVINCES OF THE ISLAND OF MINDANAO AND OF THE VARIOUS ISLANDS AND ISLETS WITHIN THE IMMEDIATE PERIPHERY OF SAID ISLAND OF MINDANAO INCLUDING THAT OF THE ISLAND CITY OF BASILAN AND OF THE VARIOUS ISLANDS WHICH COMPRISE THE SULU ARCHIPELAGO and such other places where said pest may be known to exist shall be considered as formally declared infested with this pest and under quarantine.

This Amendatory Notice shall take effect on July 1, 1965.
