As such, they are tasked to do the following functions:

Administration

1. Develop and plan the national residue monitoring program (NRMP)
2. Formulate policy of the residue monitoring and surveillance
3. Evaluate and assess the implementation of the NRMP
4. Identify and develop training programs on residue monitoring
5. Administrative supervision of the program

Field Operation

1. Coordinate and implement NRMP
2. Coordinate and implement policy of the residue monitoring
3. Coordinate training programs on residue monitoring

Laboratory Services

1. Coordinate laboratory requirements for residue monitoring
2. Develop methods of analysis for residues
3. Coordinate sampling requirements for residue analysis
4. Identify training needs of analysts

Traveling expenses and overtime payment that will be incurred for the purpose of this activity shall be charged against funds of each respective regions subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force until revoked in writing. All orders and memoranda inconsistent hereto are deemed revoked.
