

BPI Quarantine Administrative Order No. 6
Series of 1986

SUBJECT: Amending Certain Provisions of BPI Quarantine Administrative Order No. 1. Series of 1981.

WHEREAS, certain portions of some of the provisions of SPI Quarantine Administrative Order No. 1, Series of 1981 need to be amended in order to express more accurately the intents of the said Order:

WHEREAS, there have been changes, developments and new information in plant quarantine administration which necessitate adjustments in the implementation of Plant Quarantine regulations;

WHEREAS, due to a series of changes in the economic status of the country, certain rates and charges are no longer relevant for the efficient and effective discharge of functions of Plant Quarantine personnel;

WHEREFORE, pursuant to Section 17, of P.D. 1433, the Director of Plent Industry hereby promulgates the amendments of certain provisions of SPI Quarantine Administrative Order No. 1, Series of 1981.

SECTION 1. The following provisions of BPI Plant Quarantine Order No. 1, Series of 1981 is hereby amended to read as follows:

RULE I

h. "Potential Pests" - shall comprise certain kinds
of animals that are liable to become agricultural
crop pests, such as insects, monkeys, rodents,
bats, finches, rabbits, snails, sparrows, parakeets, crows, and other vertebrates.

RULE IX
Overtime Services

a. Prescribed Overtime Hours;

(s-2) Rate of Eventine Therges:

Services of BPI Plant Querantine Officers, Fumigators, Laborers and Helpers performed outside the official working hours shall be paid by the party or parties being served at the rate of fifteen Pesos (P15.00) per hour for Plant Quarantine Officers and Fumigators and Twelve Pesos (P12.00) per hour for laborers and/or helpers.

b. Meal Allowance:

Plant Quarantine personnel rendering overtime services shall be entitled to claim meet allowances at the rate of Twenty Five Pesos (P/25.00) per meet, whenever such overtime work coincides with meet time. Provided, however, that when the party or parties being served are willing to provide satisfactory meats during the overtime periods, this privilege may be waived.

c. Transportation Allowance:

(c-1) For trips inside Metro Manila and other metropolitan areas or cities, there shall be a fixed rate of Thirty Five Pesos (F35.00) traveling or transportation allowance each way from office/residence to place of work and vice-verse.

SECTION 2. Any person, natural or juridical who contravenes or violates any of the provisions of this Order, or forgas, counterfeits, alters, defaces or destroy any document issued by virtus hereof, shall suffer the panalties provided for under Section 23 of P.D. 1433, which is a fine of not more than \$720,000.00 or by imprisonment from prision correctional to prision mayor or both at the discretion of the count.

SECTION 3. This Order shall take expect inmediately and shall supersede all orders inconsistent // repiin.
