MEMORANDUM ORDER

No. <u>02</u> Series of 2012

SUBJECT:

TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF FMD-SUSCEPTIBLE ANIMALS, THEIR PRODUCTS AND BY-PRODUCTS ORIGINATING FROM PARAGUAY

WHEREAS, based on the official report submitted to the Office International des Epizooties by Dr. Hugo Federico Idoyaga Benitez, Director General, SENACSA, Comercio Exterior y Relaciones Internationales de SENACSA (Servicio Nacional de Calidad y Salud Animal), there was an outbreak of Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) in Paraguay;

WHEREAS, the FMD was confirmed last 2 January 2012 in a cattle farm in San Pedro, Aguaray Amistad, San Pedro, Paraguay;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the entry of FMD-susceptible animals, their products and by-products originating from Paraguay to protect the health of the local livestock population;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the entry of FMD and maintain the freedom of country from this disease;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PROCESO J. ALCALA, Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergency measures:

- 1. Banning the importation of FMD-susceptible animals, their products and by-products originating from Paraguay;
- 2. Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation of the application and issuance of Veterinary Quarantine Clearance (VQC)/SPS to Import of the above-stated commodities from Paraguay by the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI);
- 3. Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of FMD-susceptible animals, their products and by-products into the country originating from Paraguay by all DA Veterinary Quarantine Officers/Inspectors at all major ports.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
