SUBJECT: TEMPORARY BAN ON THE IMPORTATION OF DOMESTIC AND WILD BIRDS AND THEIR PRODUCTS INCLUDING POULTRY MEAT, DAY OLD CHICKS, EGGS AND SEMEN ORIGINATING FROM THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

WHEREAS, the Ministry of Health in the People's Republic of China has confirmed the presence of highly pathogenic H7N9 Avian Influenza in poultry in Shanghai and neighboring regions on the Eastern seaboard;


WHEREAS, there is a possibility that some travelers may bring in birds and other poultry products from the People's Republic of China;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prevent the entry of pathogenic virus causing Avian flu to protect the health of the local poultry population;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, PROCESO J. ALCALA, Secretary of Agriculture, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby institute the following emergency measures:

1. Banning the importation of domestic and wild birds and their products, including day-old chicks, eggs and semen from the People's Republic of China;
2. Immediate suspension of the processing, evaluation, and issuance of Veterinary Quarantine Clearance/ International Veterinary Certificate Import Permit for applications relevant to the importation of the above-stated commodities from the People's Republic of China by the Bureau of Animal Industry;
3. Stoppage and confiscation of all shipments of poultry and poultry products into the country originating from the People's Republic of China by all Department of Agriculture Quarantine Inspectors/Officers at all major sea/air ports.

This **Order** shall take effect immediately.
